ORDER (ORAL)

Hon'ble Mr. Manish Garg, Member (J)

M.A. No.3932/2023 is allowed subject to just exceptions.

2. The present Original Application (O.A.) has been filed by the applicant under Section 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985, seeking the following reliefs:-

"A. Quash the impugned inaction of the respondents whereby they are cancelling the offer of the appointment of the applicants, being arbitrary, malafide, discriminatory and illegal;

B. Direct the Respondent No. 1 to dispose the representation given by the applicant expeditiously.

C. Direct the respondents to issue joining letter to the applicant for the post of Dass Grade 2 at the earliest;

D. Direct the respondents to consider the Non creamy layer certificate and grant a last and final opportunity to applicant also.

E. Direct the respondent applicant seniority fix as per merit and give all the consequential benefits to the applicant.

F. Direct the respondents to produce all the records of the case along with their reply for perusal by this Hon'ble Tribunal;

G. Allow the cost of this application to the applicant.

H. Pass such other orders or reliefs as deemed fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case in the favour of the applicant and against the respondents."



3. At the outset, learned counsel for the applicant states that the applicant would be satisfied if a direction is given to the respondents to dispose of the pending representations Annexure A-7 (colly), within a limited time frame.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents is also present.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the applicant, we hereby direct the competent authority amongst the respondents to consider the aforesaid representations of the applicant and dispose of the same by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of four weeks' from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this Order. A copy of the speaking order so passed be given to the applicant. It is clarified that we have not entered into the merits of the case.
6. With the above directions, the Original Application stands disposed of accordingly.
7. No order as to costs.
